Minutes of the Meeting of the Community Committee held in the Main Hall, Park House on 26 January 2009.

PRESENT: N Cox (Chair), J Walton, E Hudson, J Garratt, L Adlam, M Neal and A Robotham (Clerk).
Also in attendance Councillor H Eppel.

- 1) **APOLOGIES:**
Apologies were noted from L Breckon (Work).
- 2) **DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST:**
 - a) None.
- 3) **MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING:**
 - a) **RESOLVED** that the Minutes of the Meeting held on 24 November 2008 be approved as a correct record. They were duly signed as a correct record.
- 4) **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:**
 - a) Public Speaking Protocol – There were no registered speakers.
 - b) There were no members of the public present and the meeting was not suspended.
- 5) **PARISH PLAN:**
 - a) It was reported that the steering group had met on 3 December 2008 and that attendees had indicated that, whilst they would offer support and assistance, they did not feel that they could organise the project. A further meeting is to be held on 4 February 2009.
- 6) **TERMS OF REFERENCE:**
 - a) In consideration of a review of the terms of reference for the Community Committee it was **RESOLVED** to defer the item to the next meeting of the Community Committee.
- 7) **COMMUNITY ISSUES:**
 - a) Climate Change.
 - i) H Eppel presented a report regarding the Climate Friendly Communities Seminar that he had been asked to attend on behalf of the Community Committee. In consideration of this report it was **RESOLVED** to recommend to Full Council that they, in principle, adopt the Leicestershire Together Declaration on Climate Change and that, subject to a satisfactory explanation by ENABLE of the contents of the declaration, the declaration be fully adopted.
 - b) Cooks Walk.
 - i) In consideration of a resident's concerns about Cooks Walk and information supplied by the Neighbourhood Police Team, it was **RESOLVED** that Glenfield Parish Council was unable to take any direct action, to advise Leicestershire County Council about the concerns and to advise the complainant accordingly.
 - c) Youth Champion.
 - i) In consideration of the request by the Youth Leaders for a Youth Champion to whom youths could make a direct approach it was **RESOLVED** to nominate L Breckon as a Youth Champion. It was further noted that K Garratt was prepared to act as a Youth Champion and that the Glenfield Youth Club should be advised that all councillors were available for support.

8) **CORRESPONDENCE:**

- a) Voluntary Action Blaby re community transport in Glenfield – this was noted.
- b) Blaby DC re attendance of the parking team on Glenfield Frith Drive – this was noted.
- c) Blaby DC re Dog Control Orders – this was noted.
- d) RCC re village competition – it was noted that Glenfield was now too large to enter the competition.
